Mission Statement:

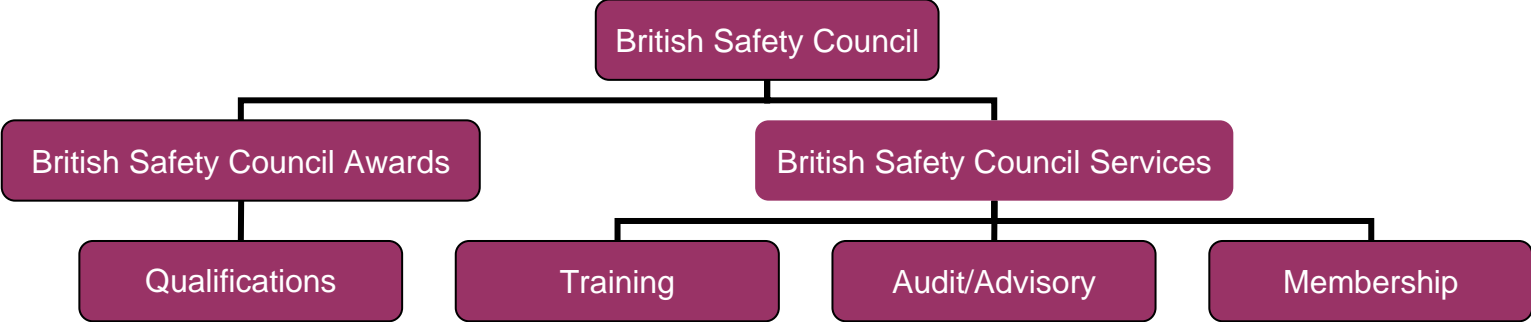
*To promote health, safety and environmental best practice for the benefit of society and the increase of Productivity*

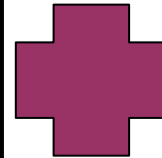
